

Towards a "Local Government Alliance for Disaster Risk Reduction"

"2nd Consultative Meeting

Final Agenda

Chengdu, China, 12-14 November 2008

Context

Local-level implementation of the Hyogo Framework for Action remains one of the major challenges to achieve, requiring the active participation and involvement of local government actors, at different levels. From the regional to the municipal level, local governments have a key role to play in reducing disaster risks and vulnerabilities.

Today, a broad consensus has been reached among different stakeholders on the need to establish a mechanism that brings together local governments to address DRR issues in a more coherent and inclusive manner, and bridges the existing gap between the local, national and global levels.

This meeting, jointly organised by UNISDR, the UNDP Special Unit for South-South Cooperation and the International Training Centre of the ILO, will serve as a learning opportunity and a brainstorming session to further advance the development of the LGA/DRR.

Objectives of the Meeting

Based on the outcomes of the 1st Consultative Meeting of the LGA/DRR held in Barcelona on 22-23 May 2008 (http://www.unisdr.org/lgadrr), this meeting will aim to gather additional inputs from local and regional authorities on how to address DRR issues at the sub-national level, and will stimulate a constructive debate around a number of issues. Overall, the meeting is expected to reach the following objectives:

- To provide an opportunity for local and regional authorities to learn from the Sichuan Earthquake response and recovery experience through participation in the plenary session of the "Global Dialogue" on 12th November.
- To review major decisions made in Barcelona, assess progress made up to the Chengdu Meeting, and agree on the way forward.
- To review the draft ToRs for the LGA/DRR and the Alliance "Advisory Group".
- To share lessons learned and discuss opportunities for collaboration within the framework of UNISDR's World Campaign on Disaster Risk Reduction.

Expected Outcomes

As a result of this meeting, it is expected that substantive comments and observations on the draft ToRs for the LGA/DRR and Advisory Group will be put forward, and that a greater understanding of and commitment to the Alliance will be reached. Opportunities for joint work and collaboration will be discussed, as well as next steps and follow-up actions leading to the key events scheduled in 2009.

Preparatory Requirements

Each participant is required to review the draft ToRs for the LGA/DRR and the Alliance Advisory Group, a copy of which will be circulated in due course. This will allow for efficient use of time, and will contribute to stimulating lively and productive discussions.
