Report	 National Institute for Land and Infrastructure Management (NILIM) organized the symposium of the public consciousness education against the flood disaster under the subtitle of "new partnership between citizens & governments for flood resistant community." The symposium consisted of two parts: 1) keynote speeches by Mr. Muneharu Nakagai, Mayor of Toyooka City and Mr. Bruce Stewart, Assistant Director, Bureau of Meteorology Australia; and 2) brainstorming session, at which participants explored their ideas on " the most effective measures for the mitigation/reduction of damages caused by floods " through the group discussion.
	The results of the group discussions were presented by the group leaders and complied in the list, from which each participant voted two priority issues. Their comments/opinions were classified into the following three points;
	-Capacity building, education and training, and school education -Information transmission/receipt, early warning, and communication
	-Research on the past disasters and learning from the lessons
