Report	The aims of this conference were facilitating the exchanges between international volunteer groups, increasing the knowledge of effective disaster-reduction measures, and establishing a network for further cooperation in the future. In the keynote speeches, Craig Nemitz, National Voluntary Organizations Active in Disaster, introduced the mitigation efforts to reduce the impact of disasters in the USA and NTT Comware Corporation demonstrated a new support system using cellular telephones with an inbuilt digital camera. The launching Ceremony for "the Forum for Wisdom" was held, which had a purpose to achieve collecting, disseminating, and exchanging the information on volunteer activities of disaster relief and reduction on the Web. Not only Japanese, but also Turkish, Iranian, Indian, and Korean disaster volunteers presented their activities in the case study session and the panel discussion. The conference adopted the KOBE Declaration, which aimed to promote a construction of network between government, NGOs, civil society groups, voluntary groups, and international organizations, and which intended to activate a collection and exchange of the wisdom on disaster prevention and relief, and drive for establishing a disaster reduction culture from the viewpoint of citizens.
