Report	Welcoming more than 500 children and their families, the p uppet play " the Fire of Inamura (rice sheaves)" was stage d. The story depicts what happened when an enormous tida I wave (tsunami) caused by the Nankai Earthquake attacked a little village on the Kii Peninsula in western Japan in 18 54. The villagers were unaware of its coming, busy at home with the preparations for an upcoming festival. A village chi ef spotted the threat from his hilltop location, set fire to his rice sheaves, a year' s precious harvest, to attract his fell ow villagers from their homes below in order to save them f rom the tsunami. The second part of the program following the puppet play, a participatory panel discussion was held. There several exp erts explained and told children about the mechanism of ear thquakes and tsunami, their terror and importance of disaste r prevention. This project, collaboration of sixteen puppet troupes as well as NGOs and corporate volunteers, has started since Janua ry 2004 and has been supported by a fund set up by the e mployee-managed volunteer organization of Sompo Japan In surance in addition to donations from the public. Taking place less than one month after the Indian Ocean ts unami disaster, our endeavor was given much attention by t he media. We believe that the event delivered many childre n the message of importance of being prepared for the futu re disaster reduction as well as the preciousness of life. (23 1 words)
