

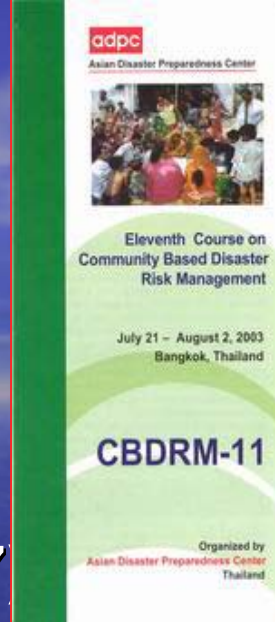

Understanding institutionalization?

Multi-sectoral and multi-level process

A state where role of community groups is recognized by the government and their efforts are supported.

Performance of following functions by the government officials and departments in collaboration with at-risk communities:

- Group formation/strengthening;
- Risk communication;
- Technical skills development;
- Funds for risk reduction actions;
- Physical inputs e.g. seeds, plants, construction materials;
- Technical advice to individuals, families and groups;
- Linking Scientific knowledge with community coping mechanisms;

- **National adaptation of CBDRM training;**
- **Mobilize municipal and local government;**
- **Build technical capacity of municipal, commune and local government in facilitation;**

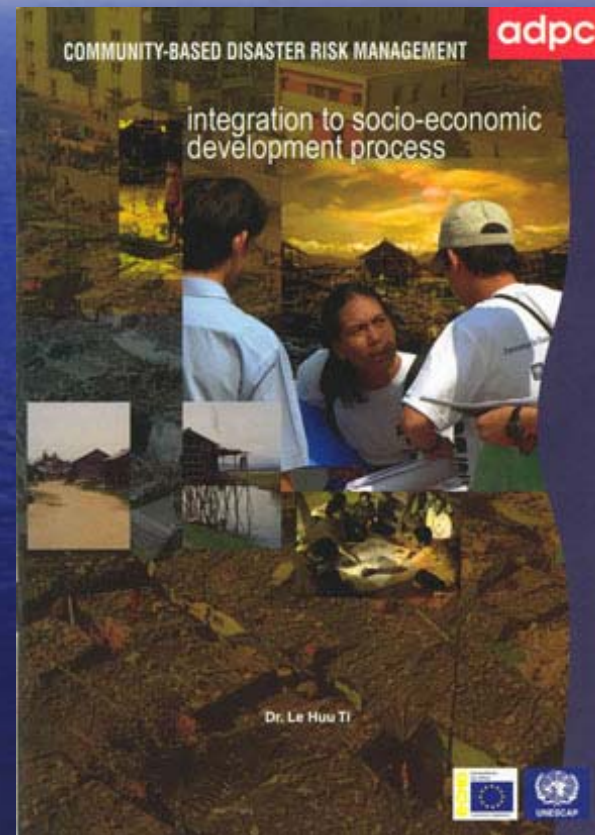
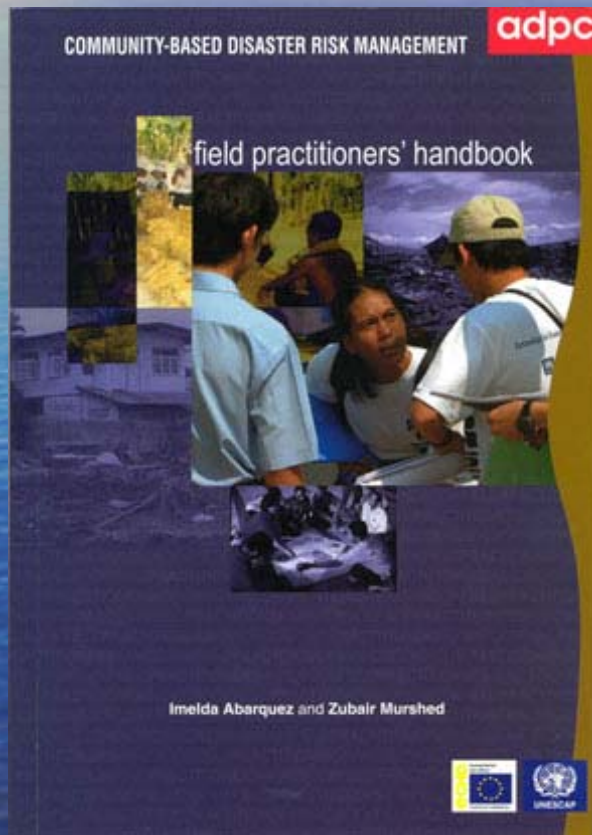

Pointers on Damage and Needs Assessment

The clear and concise assessment of damages, losses and injuries in the aftermath of a disaster is a prerequisite for the effective planning and implementation of relief and recovery. Listed below are some key points about damage and needs assessment.

1. The objectives of assessments both damage and needs are to determine:

- Nature and extent of disaster
- Damage and secondary threats
- Needs of the population
- Resource availability and local response capacity
- Options for relief assistance, long-term recovery and devt.
- Needs for international assistance

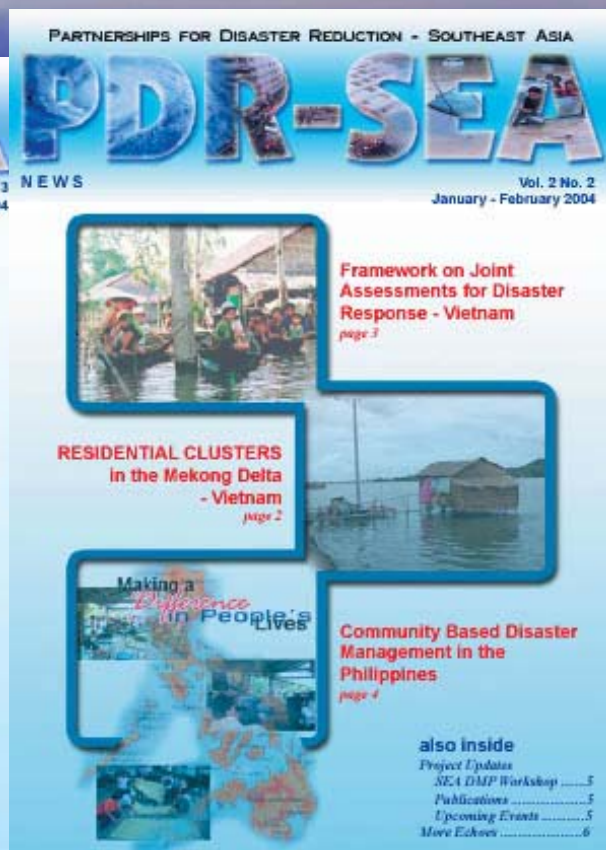

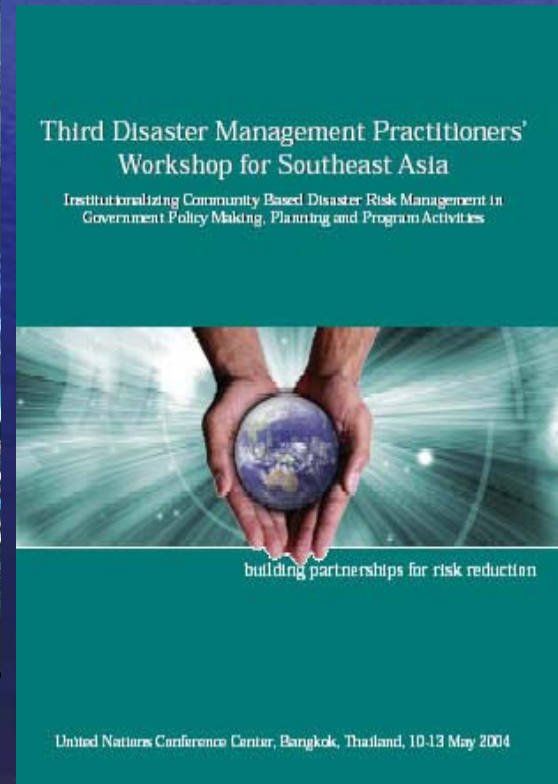
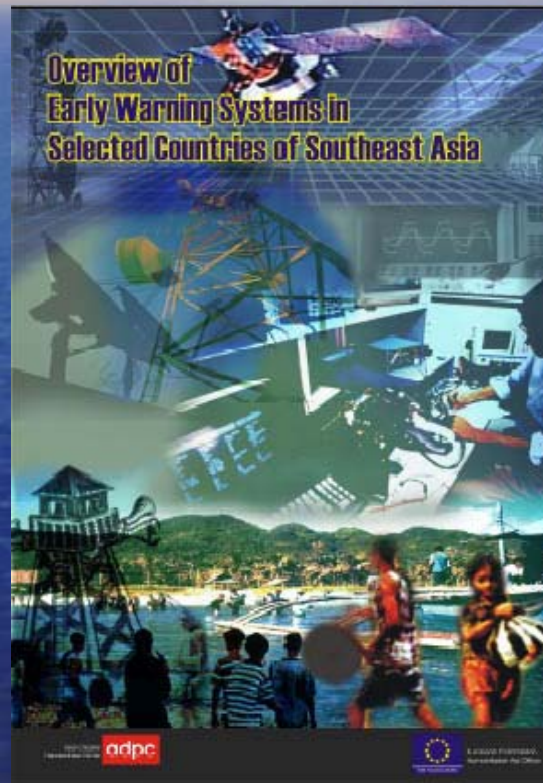
