

Tehran City Amaken Project, Iran



The Iranian capital of Tehran is located at the foot of the Alborz Mountains. The region is earthquake-prone. Historical records indicate the last big earthquake was in 1830. The Tehran Disaster Management and Mitigation Organization (TDMMO) is the responsible body for all disasters within the Tehran area. It coordinates with several stakeholders to cover all stages of disaster management including mitigation and preparedness; emergency response; reconstruction and rehabilitation.

The project named Disaster Management Teams Formation Plan for Tehran City (Amaken) relies on residents and office workers, who besides their daily duties, have also volunteered to receive the required disaster risk management training modules to strengthen safety and mitigate possible hazards and risk in their homes and work places.
