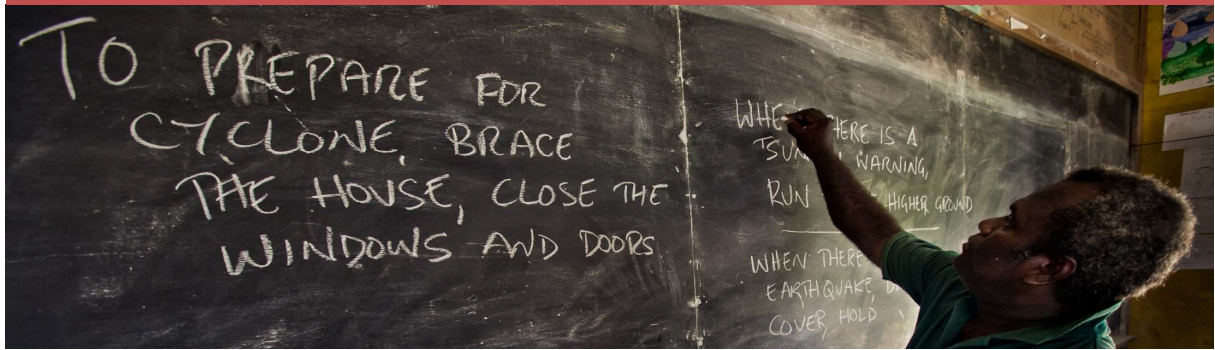


Interactive Simulation: Reducing Risks through Community Resilience Partnerships
