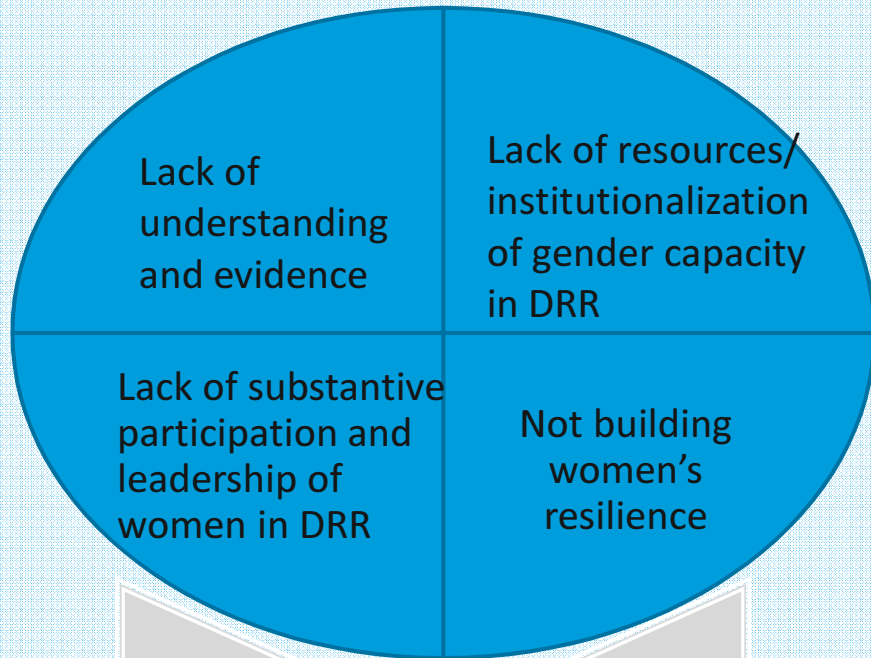

DRR as Usual versus GIR

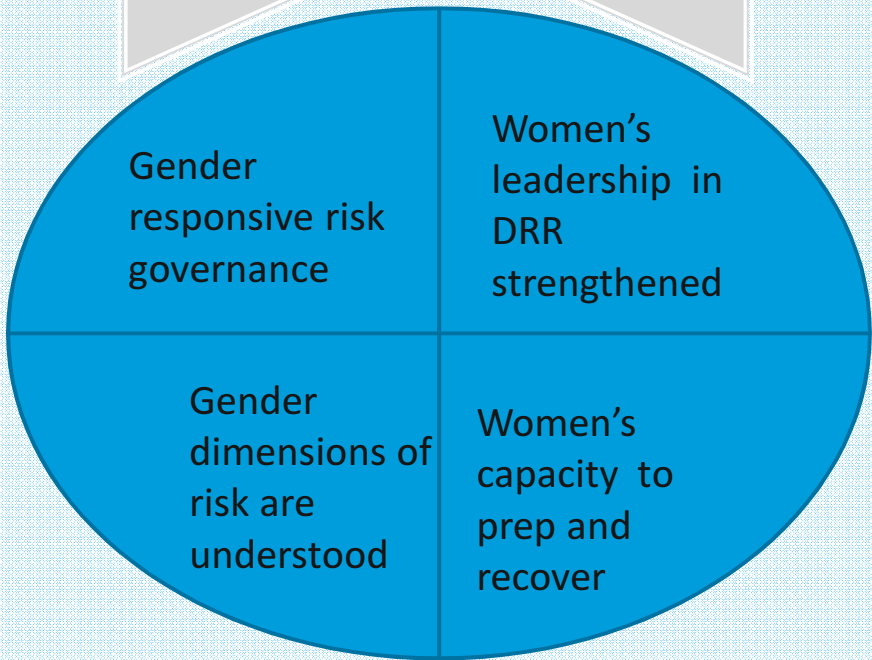


Less effective in saving lives and reducing loss and damage; do not leverage women's leadership and strengths

Key Components

- Global advocacy at international forums and platforms, advocacy products in support of country level
- Support and technical assistance (TA) to intergovernmental processes, global accountability and monitoring mechanisms, methodologies, analytical frameworks, data and assessment tools, and guidance related to Sendai Framework
- Consolidation of the global evidence and knowledge base, including undertaking research, data collection and guidance to support country level
- Facilitate and convene global/cross regional gender and DRR champions and networks for knowledge exchange, best practices and joint advocacy
- Convene global gender and DRR champions including private sector

- TA and support to country level implementation
- Policy Support Package to countries beyond the pilot countries
- Regional advocacy, policy dialogue and media outreach
- TA and support to regional DRR bodies, processes, accountability and monitoring mechanisms
- Collect and share best practices within regions
- Promotion of South-South cooperation
- Engagement of national and regional women's organizations in regional DRR processes
- Capacity development with regional actors

- Capacity and leadership development of national women's organizations and gender advocates
- TA and support to assessments, SADD collection, analysis and usage
- Support to reviews of legal frameworks and policies on DRR
- Support to institutionalization of capacity for gender responsive DRM and gender mainstreaming in DRR planning, budgeting and monitoring at national and local level
- TA and support the establishment of inclusive and gender responsive disaster management platforms
- TA and support to the development of national monitoring systems for implementation of Sendai framework
- TA and support to development of gender sensitive micro social protection, disaster compensation, early warning systems and livelihood opportunities for women
